## Rules and Liability Waiver:

- No smoking, alcohol, or candle/flames are allowed.
- No outside food is permitted. Birthday cakes and/or cupcakes are admitted.
- A cleaning fee of \$25.00 per hour will be assessed if the facility is left in an unreasonable condition.
- Renter further acknowledges and understands that lifeguards are not responsible for providing supervision. Lifeguards are responsible for enforcing safety rules and responding to emergencies.
- All rules and regulations of the Madison Aquatic Center will be observed and must be followed at all times.
- Renter will provide appropriate supervision. Adult supervisor (s) must remain until the last participant leaves the Madison Aquatic Center.
- When deemed necessary by the Madison Aquatic Center, the lessee must provide proof of insurance.

## **AGE GUIDELINES:**

- A guardian or responsible person 16 years of age or older must be *in* the water within an arm's reach actively supervising children age 3 years and younger.
- A guardian or responsible person 16 years of age or older must be present in the pool area with any child ages 4 through 6 or else the child must get out of the pool. No exceptions.

## **GENERAL USAGE POLICIES**

- The Aquatic Center is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Lockers located on the north desk next to the building; please bring a padlock to secure items. All belongs and locks MUST BE REMOVED at the end of each day. The department reserves to right to cut off any locks left overnight and to put contents of the locker in the lost and found.
- Items kept on deck must be stored under chairs or along the far edge of the deck; loose items will not be allowed within 12 feet of the water's edge.
- Towles may be used at the water's edge as long as someone is sitting on them. Unattended towels pose a tripping and/or safety problem for other patrons. Towles are NOT allowed in the water.
- This facility does not guarantee that chaise lounges or chairs will be available to all patrons. Loungers and chairs
  must be kept 12 feet from the water's edge.
- Paper or cloth diapers are not allowed. Swim Diapers must be worn on deck and in the water by any person not trained to use the restrooms.
- Diapers must be changed at changing stations only.
- Lifejackets, floatables, water-wings, or inflatables are NOT ALLOWED in the pool. Swimwear with floats sewn into the suit are allowed. Goggles and small pool toys are allowed at manger's discretion.
- Swimsuits MUST be worn. Nylon or Spandex tank tops and/or shorts, or swim-armor are allowed with swimsuit.
   NO t-shirts allowed in the pool for any reason.
- Patrons must shower before entering the pool. Patrons with open wounds such as rashes, skin diseases, or open sores are not allowed. Patrons with eye infections are not allowed.
- No outside food, gum, or glass containers in the pool area. Water is acceptable in a plastic container.
